ASK THE UMPIRE – AUGUST 2023

Nasty Norm thought he knew Helpful Herbert's weakness and he was right! Helpful Herbert and his rink were having trouble playing long ends!

Nasty Norm's side had won the toss and as luck would have it, Nasty Norm was playing Helpful Herbert.

Nasty Norm told his lead Fast Freddy at the beginning of the match that he was to place the mat on the T and roll the jack to the T at the other end. This plan worked well for the first 5 ends but on the 6th end Fast Freddy had a rush of blood and propelled the jack into the ditch.

Helpful Herbert was happy that he could now dictate the length of the end. He therefore told his lead, Dopey Dora, that she was to bring the mat up to the 21-metre mark and roll the jack to the T. Dopey Dora obediently picked up the mat and was walking down the green when Nasty Norm yelled at her "you have to leave the mat where it was".

Helpful Herbert immediately yelled "we can move the mat". Before a barney ensued, Helpful Herbert called the umpire. The club's newest umpire strode up, clutching his new law book and ruled in favour of Helpful Herbert.

Dopey Dora thereupon placed the mat but unfortunately proceeded to roll the jack out of bounds.

Various opinions were offered as to what should happen next but to save time Nasty Norm called the umpire. The umpire first ruled that the jack should be placed just behind the T. this made Helpful Herbert happy as the jack was where he wanted it. Nasty Norm was happy too as he told Fast Freddy to place the mat on the T at the other end.

Helpful Herbert didn't want a change in the mat position so he yelled out "the mat must stay where it is". The umpire was again called, and this time ruled in favour of Nasty Norm.

Was the umpire, right?

Umpire Barry says he was right on each occasion.

Law 10.2 states that if a jack is improperly delivered the opponent must place the mat as described in Law 6.1.1 and re-deliver the jack but the opponent must not play first.

Law 10.3 states that if the jack is improperly delivered by each player the jack must be placed with the nearest part of the jack to the mat line being 2 metres from the front ditch and the mat must be placed as described in Law 6.1.1.

Law 6.1.1 states that the player to play first must place the mat lengthwise along the centre line with the mat line at least 2 metres from the rear ditch and at least 23 metres from the front ditch. (Which means at least 21 meters from the T at the other end of the rink).
