

SATURDAY PENNANT VOLUNTEER KITCHEN DUTIES

Volunteers are requested to arrive by 2.30.

Bell for afternoon tea break will be rung by a team manager at 2.40.

Hot water is now 'on tap' in the al fresco area for pre-game drinks and afternoon tea if required. Check water level in inside urn and turn up to 95 .

Duty rink players will have set out recyclable cups, coffee, tea, sugar, teaspoons, stirrers, rubbish containers in al fresco area and inside prior to the game and put rink numbers and rubbish containers on tables.

Put a container of mixed biscuits on each table and two milk cartons on the right hand side of urn with a rubbish container and check there is adequate supply of cups, tea and coffee making items plus milk in the al fresco area after pre-game drinks.

If required, take out cups from sleeve.

Hot food items will have been placed in pie warmer and dim sim steamer and switched on by others prior to the game. During the break, turn pie warmer to 120 deg. Check water level in steamer, add water if required and keep at 90 deg.

After the break

Clear away drink making items from al fresco area and inside and put away coffee, tea, sugar, teaspoons, stirrers and biscuit containers in labelled drawers or cupboards.

Discard milk in jugs if used and wash. If cartons are open, make sure they have lids and mark with date opened.

Any unused recyclable cups to be returned to corner cupboard under microwave.

Wash teaspoons and rubbish containers.

Wipe tables and bench top inside and in al fresco area.

Put away rink numbers in box and return to bench under Honour Board.

Check urn is off.

Put out sauces from plastic container, serviettes , plates and forks ready for serving hot food at conclusion of game.
